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GENERAL ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Check each piece carefully and remove any sharp projections that may have been caused by shipping.
- 2. DO NOT Tighten nuts more than hand tight until entire assembly is completed.
- 3. All Threaded ends of bolts protruding beyond nuts should be cut off and peened over to remove any sharp edge.

SPECIFIC ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Layout and dig holes
- 2. Assemble backstop on ground with bottom of upright posts at front edge of holes. Tighten all bolts securely.
- 3. Raise and lower assembly into holes.
- 4. Plumb and Level backstop.
- 5. Pour footings. Approximate concrete required 4.7 cubic feet.

MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS:

Check periodically for loose bolts, broken parts and replace immediately.

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
