



ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Attach The Table Top (1) to the Main Post (3) by inserting $3/8 \times 1 \%$ Button Head Bolts (5) and a 3/8" washer (6) through the bottom of the mounting plate on the main post and into the factory installed nuts on the bottom side of the table and seat.
- **2.** Dig two holes 14" from wide, 24" deep and 63" from the center of one to the center of the second. Dig four holes for seat posts 32" from center of table hole to center of seat hole.
- 3. Level and square the unit and put small blocks in the holes against the main post to maintain the position of the table. After the unit is leveled, tighten all bolts.
 - 4. Once you are satisfied the unit is square and level you may fill the whole with concrete following the mixing and curing instructions from the manufacturer. After the concrete has been poured, confirm that the table didn't shift and is still square and level. Allow concrete to cure per the manufacturer's instructions before allowing the unit to be used.



Bench & Table Style Options

Style Identification

In the event a replacement part is needed, it is important that you are able to identify not only the product but the style of product you ordered. The images to the right represent all the style options that are available for the product you purchased. Please identify your style and it's corresponding part number before you contact your distributor or the manufacturer for replacement parts.

Currently, SportsPlay Equipment offers four style options. Rolled edge with perforated steel, beveled edge with perforated steel, rolled edge with expanded steel and beveled edge with expanded steel.

To identify your product style you must first define the edge. If it has a radius it is a rolled edge and if it has a 45 degree angle it is the beveled edge. Expanded steel is easily identified by it's distinct weaved pattern. The perforated steel option is simply sheet metal that has been punched with a pattern of holes.
