DIAPER CHANGING STATION – 75HS0206

Sova offers a wide range of baby and adult changing stations meeting all applicable ASTM and A.D.A requirements when properly installed. Delete options and models not required for your project and modify to your project needs.

PART 1 GENERAL

1.1 SECTION INCLUDES

- A. Diaper changing stations.

1.2 SUBMITTALS

- A. Product Data: Manufacturer's data sheets on each product to be used, including:
 - 1. Preparation instructions and recommendations.
 - 2. Storage and handling requirements and recommendations.
 - 3. Installation methods.

1.3 DELIVERY, STORAGE, AND HANDLING

- A. Store products in manufacturer's unopened packaging until ready for installation.

1.4 PROJECT CONDITIONS

- A. Maintain environmental conditions (temperature, humidity, and ventilation) within limits recommended by manufacturer for optimum results. Do not install products under environmental conditions outside manufacturer's recommended limits.

1.5 WARRANTY

- A. Warranty: Provide manufacture's standard limited 5-year warranty. All warranties are effective from the date of initial shipment from manufacturer.

PART 2 PRODUCTS

2.1 MANUFACTURERS

- A. Acceptable Manufacturer: The Sova Company
- B. Substitutions: Not permitted.

2.2 DIAPER CHANGING STATIONS

- A. Diaper changing stations shall meet ASTM safety standards, include ANSI warning labels.
- B. Attend Fixed-Height Adult Changing Table:
 - 1. Product: 75HS0206 – Attend, 76 Adult Static Steel Changing Station as manufactured by The Sova Company.
 - a. Changing surface extends 40 inches (1016 mm) from wall in open position.
 - b. Constructed of powder coated steel and is rated to support a static load of 500lb (227 kg).
 - c. Replaceable high-hygiene vacuum formed ABS tray.
 - d. Dual pneumatic gas springs provide smooth, safe open/close operation.
 - e. When closed, unit projects 9 inch (229 mm) from wall.

PART 3 EXECUTION

3.1 EXAMINATION

- A. Do not begin installation until substrates have been properly prepared.
- B. If substrate preparation is the responsibility of another installer, notify Architect of unsatisfactory preparation before proceeding.

3.2 PREPARATION

- A. Clean surfaces thoroughly prior to installation.
- B. Prepare surfaces using the methods recommended by the manufacturer for achieving the best result for the substrate under the project conditions.

3.3 INSTALLATION

- A. Install in accordance with manufacturer's instructions.

3.4 PROTECTION

- A. Protect installed products until completion of project.
- B. Touch-up, repair or replace damaged products before Substantial Completion.
